

Sizing

The width of our support pad is the main difference between the small and large size. Both sizes can support dogs up to 200 lbs, and are adjustable for dogs low to the ground so the handler may remain upright. Focus on the width of the support pad to ensure the proper fit and maximum comfort.

The new Tall size is for tall, lean dogs like Great Danes or Greyhounds. The maximum length of the Tall GingerLead is 37 inches, which allows the handle to be closer to a tall dog's back.

Our Story

Ginger, our golden retriever, was adopted at 8 weeks old along with her littermate Wilson.



At 6 months old, she was diagnosed with hip dysplasia and had a TPO surgery on her right hip. We were instructed to utilize a bath towel to support her surgically repaired hip during recovery.

We found it extremely difficult to control an excitable puppy with a bath towel. Going up and down stairs was especially challenging.

We were frequently off balance and concerned about Ginger's safety. Nevertheless, she did recover, and was her happy self again.



She enjoyed playing with Wilson, hiking, swimming and all activities dogs love. She would occasionally limp after playing hard, then be fine after a few days.

Over time, her occasional limp became a constant limp and seemed to worsen after weeks of inactivity. Then she was diagnosed with a luxating patella on her rear left knee and surgery was performed again.



After surgery a sling was provided, which was better than a towel; however, we were still unable to control Ginger. Her front legs were strong and she frequently wanted to run and jump, or dash down the stairs.

We were very concerned that she may injure her surgically repaired knee, so we decided we needed a way to connect a support sling to her collar and the GingerLead was born.
